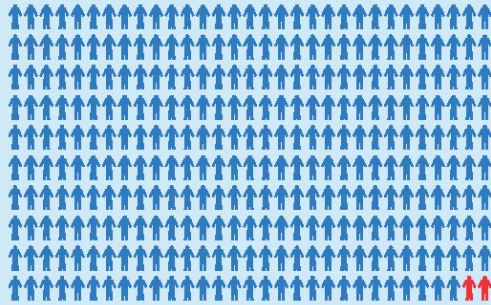

- Income disparity
- Lack of educational opportunities
- Lack of meaningful employment
- Poor housing
- Lack of hope

Social Conditions

- Inequality
- Lack of support to families & neighbourhoods
- Inaccessible services
- Lack of leadership
- Low value placed on children
- Exclusion



Family Conditions

- Parental conflict
- Parental criminality including Family Violence
- Problematic Substance use
- Erratic parenting
- Abuse and neglect of children

Prevention Formula

$$\text{Likelihood of Crime \& Victimization} = \frac{\text{Risks \& Vulnerabilities}}{\text{Resiliencies \& Capacities}}$$

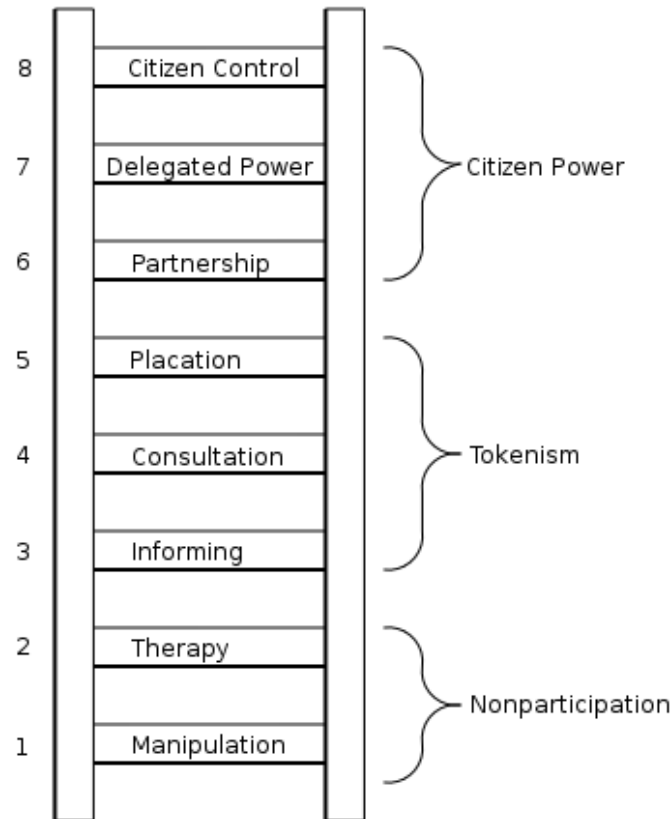

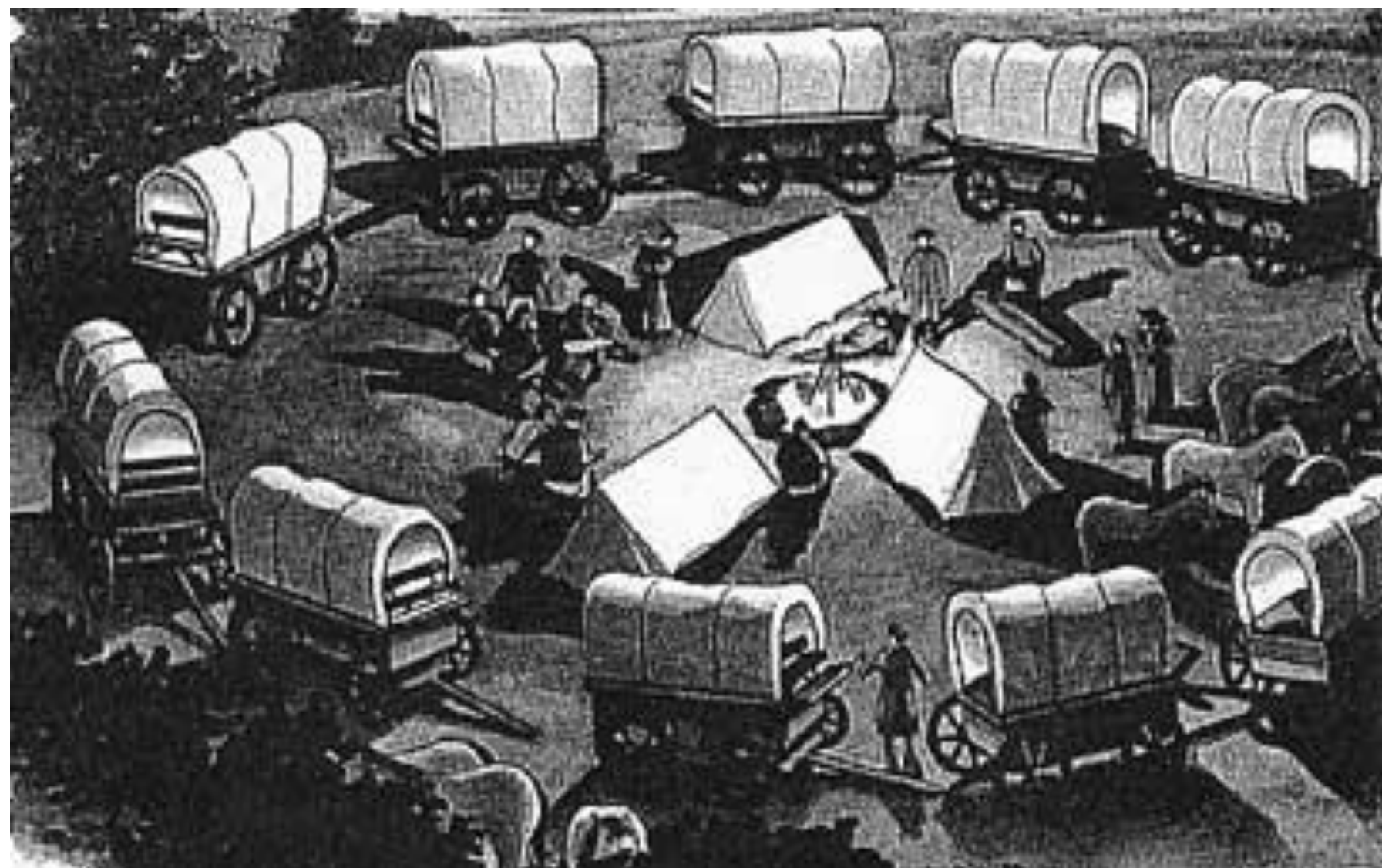
A Ladder of Citizen Participation

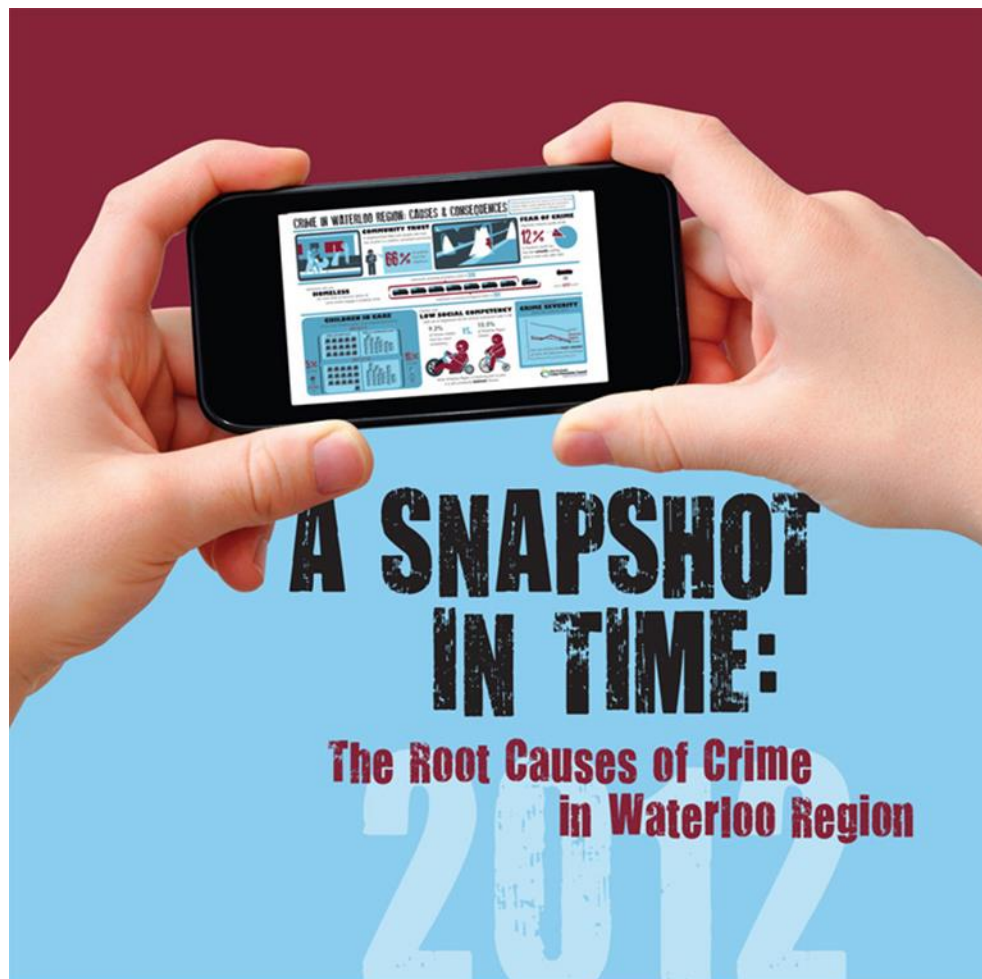

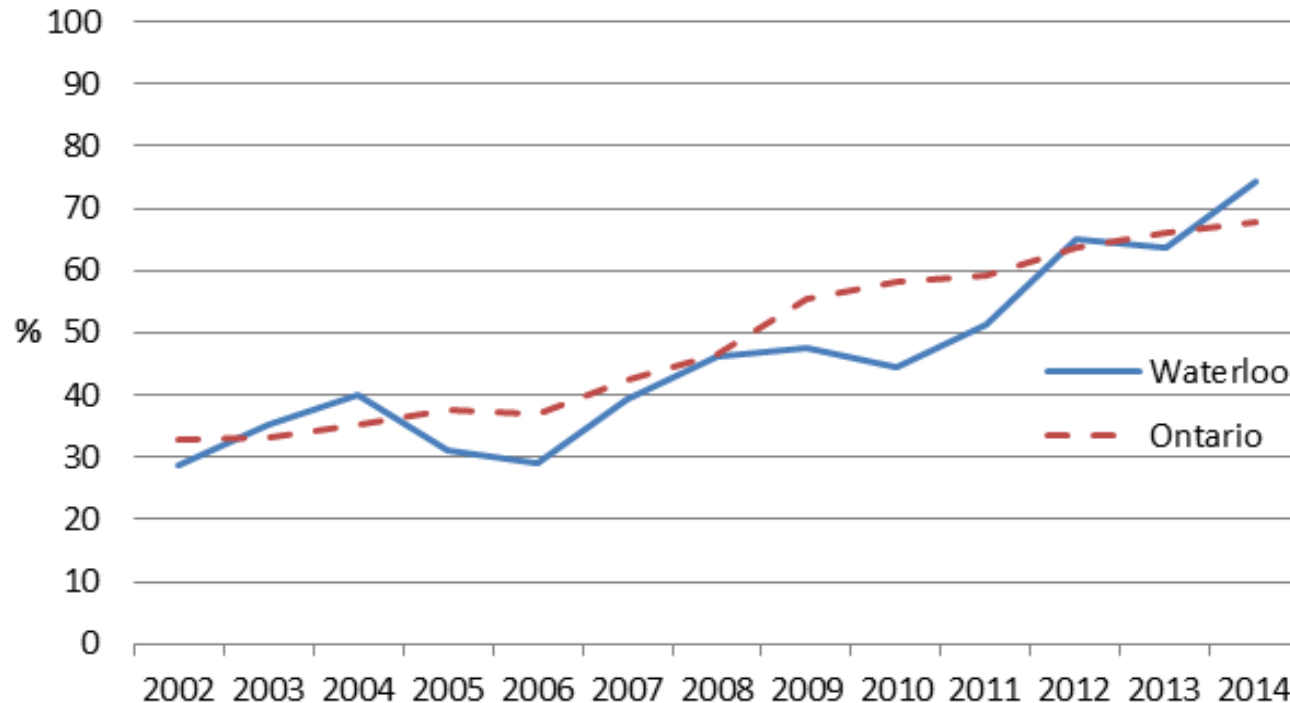






Overdose Prevention

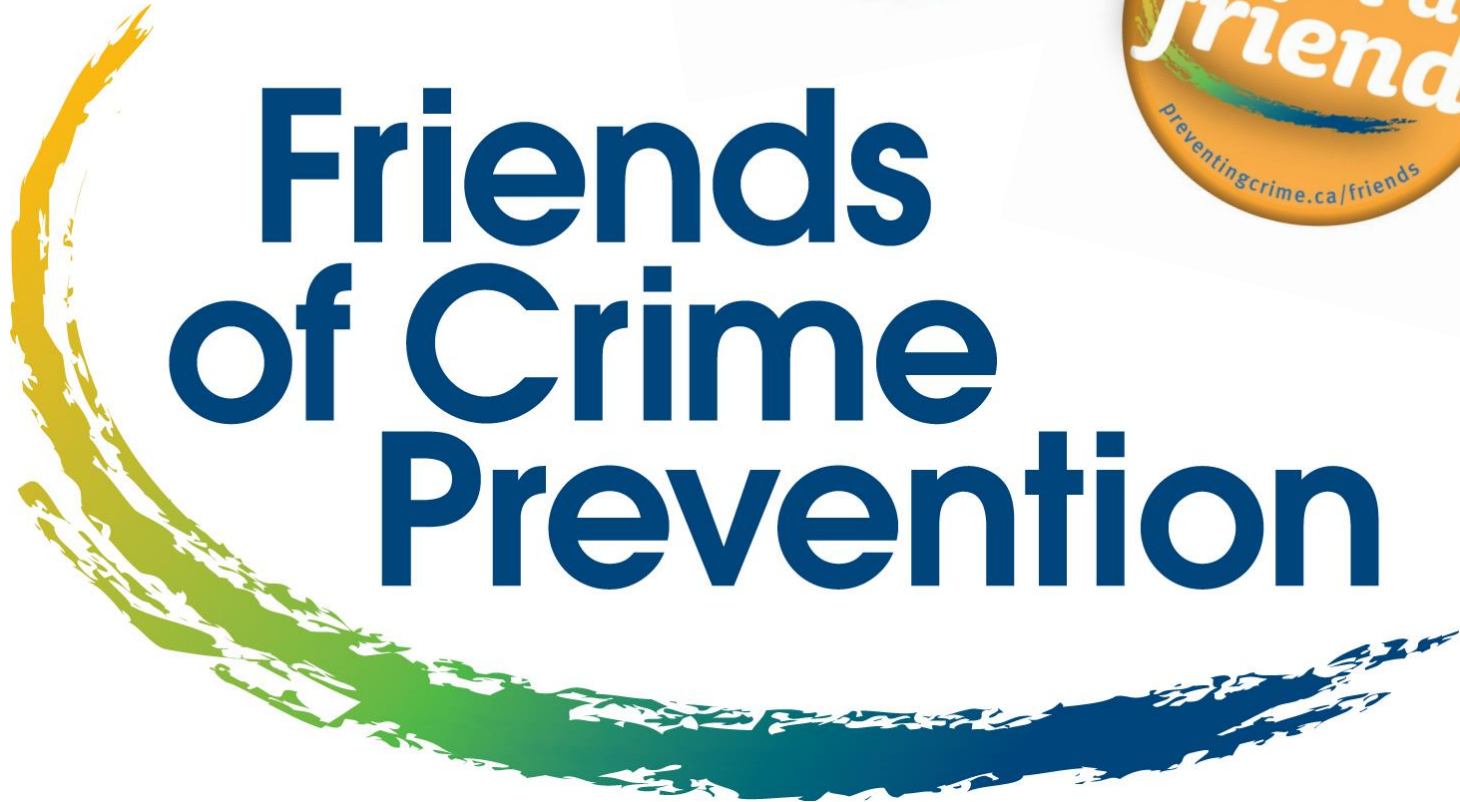


