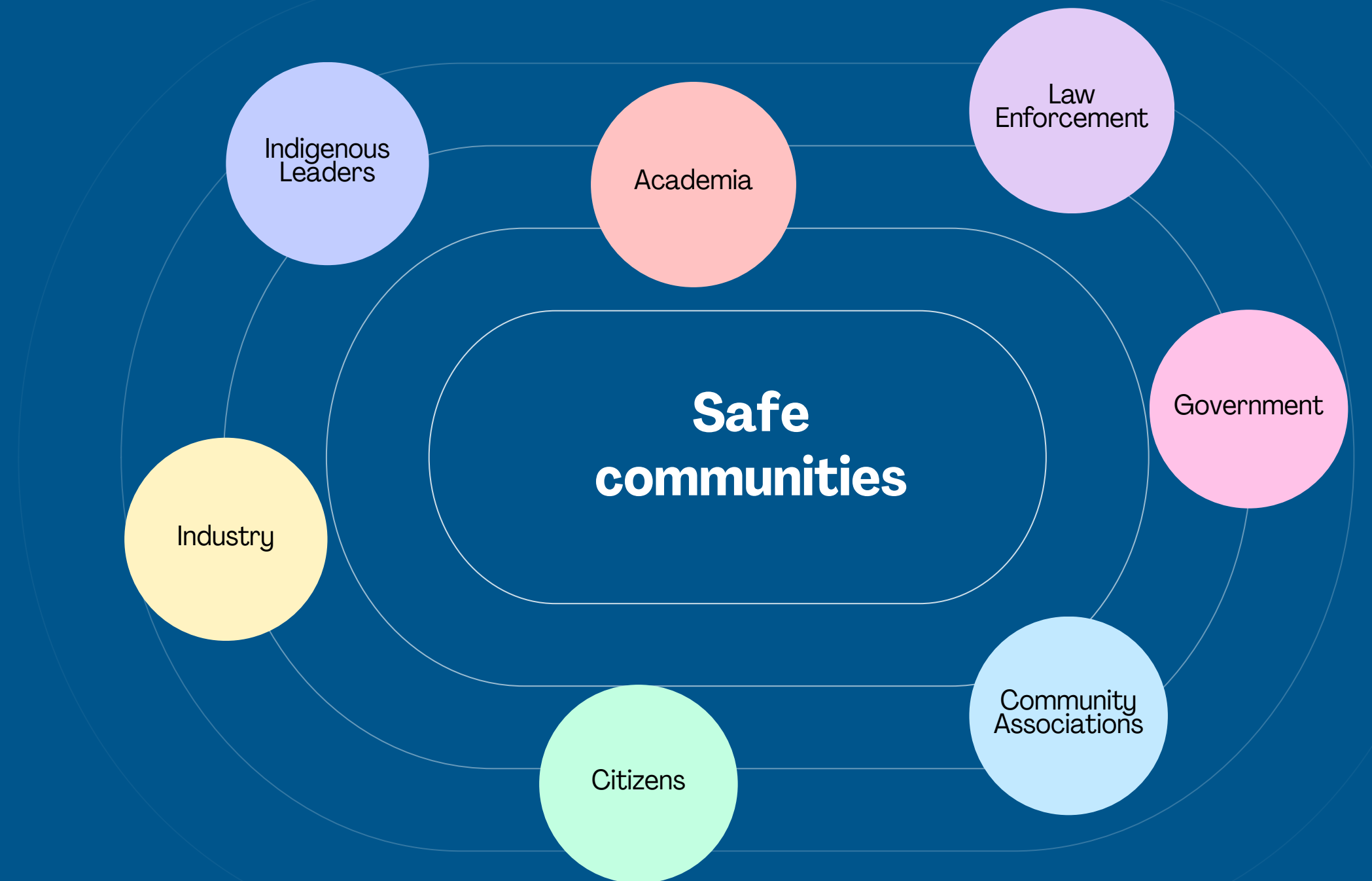


Why sponsor the ACCPA conference?

Attendees appreciated the relevance, practicality and Alberta-focused insights throughout the program.

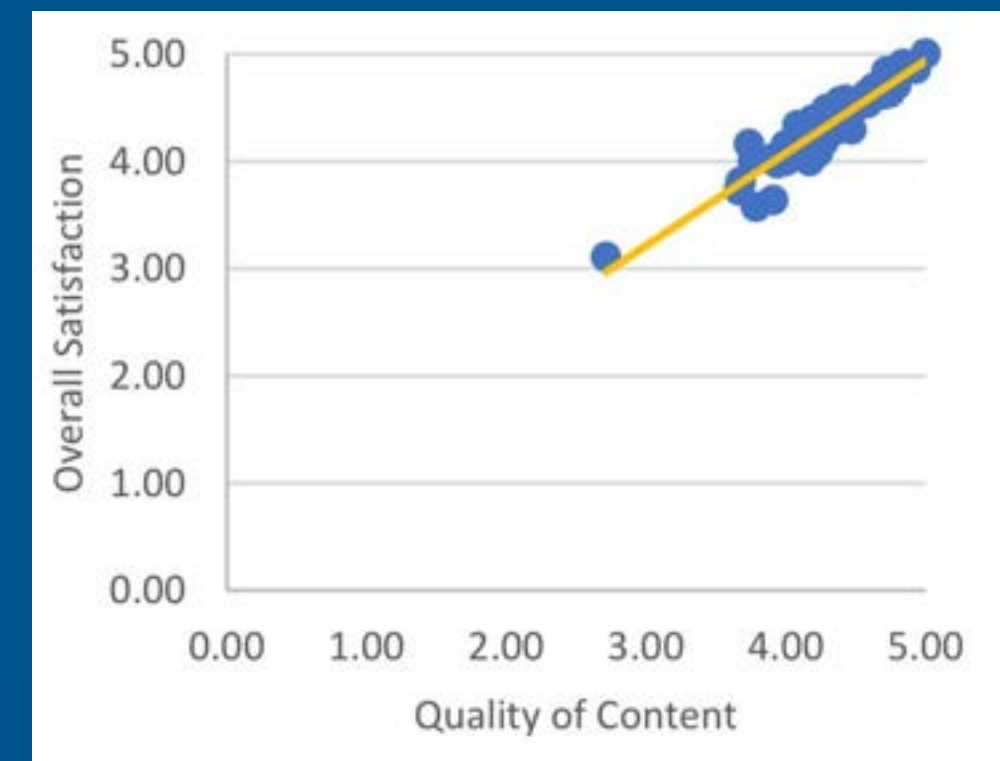
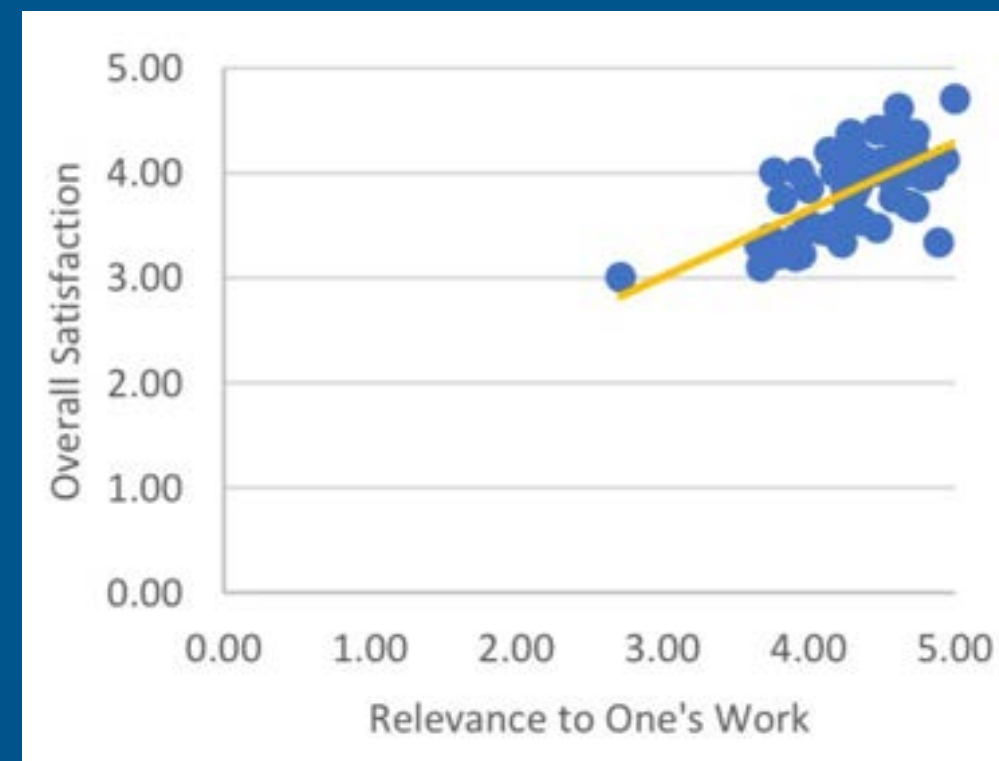
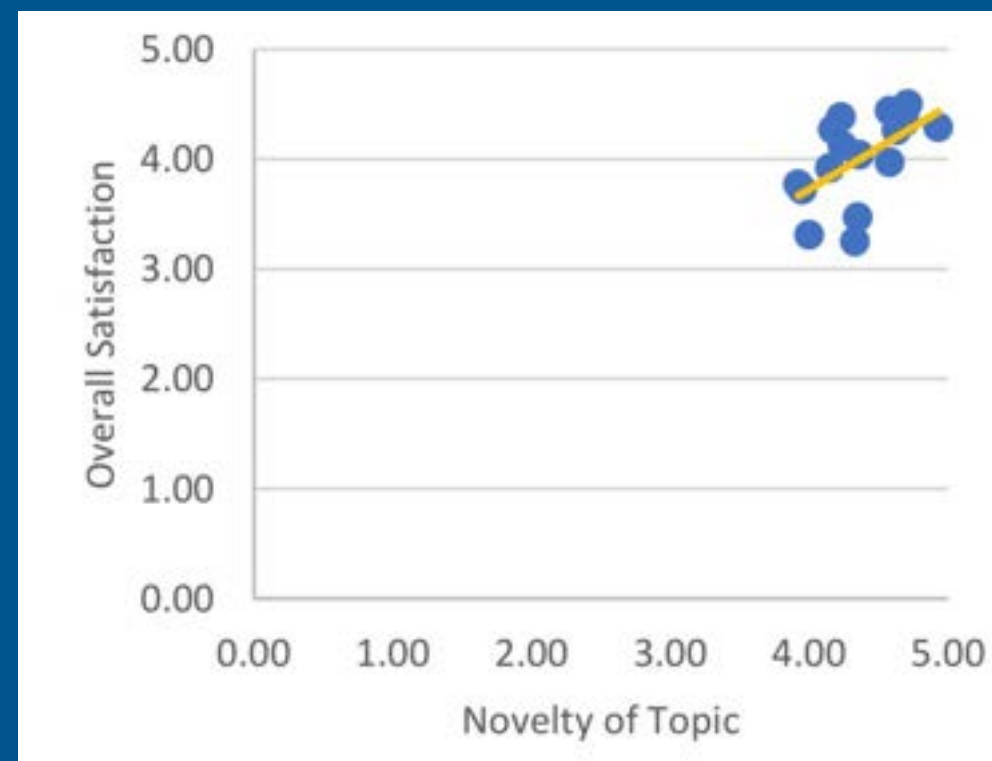
